Demonstrate First Attack Fire Fighting Equipment is a unit nationally approved and accredited and has been specifically designed to reduce the risk of fire through the promotion of fire safety awareness and basic fire training.

This is a unit of competency that is nationally endorsed with the NVR standards.

#### Course Outline

- ✓ Basic WHS and relevant emergency procedures
- ✓ Select the correct portable firefighting equipment for a particular type of fire
- ✓ Demonstrate the correct use of portable fire extinguishers to extinguish simulated fires
- ✓ Demonstrate the correct use of fire hose reels.
- ✓ Demonstrate the correct use of a fire blanket.

#### Workplace Training

To provide training at your workplace we require:

- ✓ Minimum 10 participants
- ✓ Parking for training vehicle
- ✓ Minimum of 4 sq.m safe training area away from combustible material and vehicles
- ✓ Training room for theory
- ✓ Please note: training cannot occur on restricted/total fire ban days.

#### Assessment

Written and practical assessment. Participants with literacy/numeracy difficulties or physical conditions should speak with the Trainer to discuss alternative assessment approaches.

#### Qualification

On successful completion, each participant will achieve a Statement of Attainment, with a recommended refresher of 2 years. There are no pre-requisites for this course.

#### Course Duration

2 Hours (including practical and assessment).
