MSMPER300 – Issue Work Permits

This unit of competency applies to personnel who are required to issue appropriate permits to work, to persons conducting a variety of activities in workplace environments, in which hazards exist or specific procedures need to be followed and monitored.

Course Objectives

The Issue Work Permits unit addresses the need for personnel who issue work permits to understand the permit system, know the limitations of each permit and make decisions regarding the need for and correct use of each permit.

Prerequisite

Any participants completing the Issue Work Permits training unit must also have completed Conduct Hazard Analysis MSMWHS201, as a prerequisite to this course.
